

STANDARD PILLOWCASE

CUTTING MEASUREMENTS:

Body 40" wide x 27" long

Cuff 40" wide x 11" long Trim

40" wide x 2" long

PUTTING TOGETHER:

Layout

- Layout cuff out flat with right side up
- Fold trim fabric in half lengthwise with **wrong sides** together, press
- Place the trim fabric on top edge of cuff with raw edges together, pin
- Place the pillowcase body on top of the cuff/trim with **right sides** together, re-pin

Burrito Roll

- Start at the bottom of the pillowcase body, begin rolling the fabric towards the top edge
- Take the bottom edge of the cuff and wrap it over the rolled up body fabric, pin through all layers of fabric
- Using a **1/2" seam allowance**, sew the cut edge
- When sewn, fold back one edge of the cuff and gently pull-out the body fabric (you now have one large piece with cuff, trim and body)
- Press the cuff, trim and body (ensure cuff is pressed on both sides)

French Seam

- Fold the pillowcase in half (width wise) with **WRONG** sides together. Ensure cuff and trim pieces match at side seam. Match any horizontal patterns.
- Pin around the long and bottom cut edge of fabric
- Sew these edges with a **1/4" seam allowance**, ensure your cuff and trim still match at side seam, press
- Turn pillowcase inside so **right sides** of fabric are matching. Turn lower corner, press.
- Pin sewn edges ensuring cuff matches at side seam
- Sew the side and bottom seam using **1/2" seam allowance**
- Turn pillowcase right side out, press seams flat
